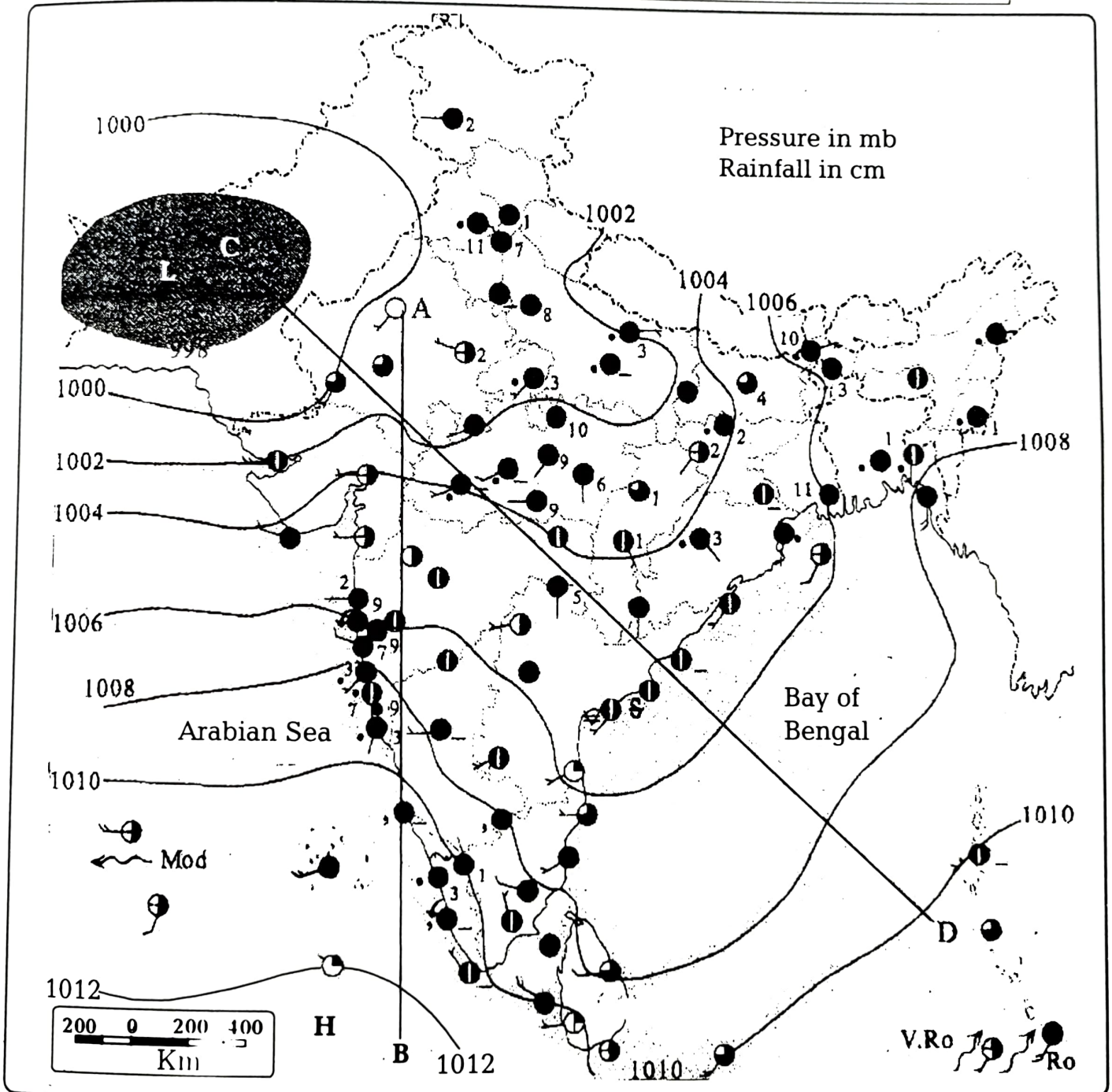


Fig. 3.16: Indian Daily Weather Report (Map No. 2)
